Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to the www.KnowWhereToHunt.com and Know Where to Hunt, LLC and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to Know Where to Hunt, LLC include www.KnowWhereToHunt.com and Know Where to Hunt. The Know Where to Hunt website is a Online Hunting Club Site site. By using the Know Where to Hunt website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

TRUSTe Privacy Program

Know Where to Hunt is a licensee of the TRUSTe Privacy Program. TRUSTe is an independent organization whose mission is to build users' trust and confidence in the Internet by promoting the use of fair information practices. Because we want to demonstrate our commitment to your privacy, we have agreed to disclose our information practices and have our privacy practices reviewed for compliance by TRUSTe. Collection of your Personal Information

Know Where to Hunt may collect personally identifiable information, such as your name. Know Where to Hunt may also collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your age and gender. We may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future. Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Know Where to Hunt. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Know Where to Hunt website. Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through Know Where to Hunt's public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others. Know Where to Hunt encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link to from Know Where to Hunt so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. Know Where to Hunt is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on websites outside of the Know Where to Hunt website.

Use of your Personal Information

Know Where to Hunt collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested. Know Where to Hunt may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Know Where to Hunt and its

affiliates. Know Where to Hunt may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered. Know Where to Hunt does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. Know Where to Hunt may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Know Where to Hunt, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information. Know Where to Hunt may keep track of the websites and pages our users visit within Know Where to Hunt, in order to determine what Know Where to Hunt services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within Know Where to Hunt to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area. Know Where to Hunt will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Know Where to Hunt or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Know Where to Hunt; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Know Where to Hunt, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The Know Where to Hunt website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you. One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Know Where to Hunt pages, or register with Know Where to Hunt site or services, a cookie helps Know Where to Hunt to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same Know Where to Hunt website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Know Where to Hunt features that you customized. You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. Verisign

Know Where to Hunt, LLC was formed by avid outdoor enthusiasts with a mission to link responsible hunters to prime hunting land. We accomplish this by building solid relationships with the landowners and bridging the gap to our active members. We work, throughout the year, with the landowners to ensure that their wishes are being met and that we are exceeding an acceptable level of expectation. The product of these relationships is better and more diverse hunting opportunities, for Know Where to Hunt members. After paying a subscription fee (Yearly, 3-day, 1-day), you can schedule a hunt, pay your daily field usage fee, and go hunt. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is

transmitted to other websites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) protocol. Verisign is an independent, third-party company engaged in the development of digital trust. Verisign provides authentication of Internet services, digital identity and intellectual property. By clicking on the Verisign logo, the Verisign website will serve up a web page that confirms that Know Where to Hunt is "Verisign Authenticated."

Children Under Thirteen

Know Where to Hunt does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of thirteen. If you are under the age of thirteen, you must ask your parent or guardian for permission to use this website.
